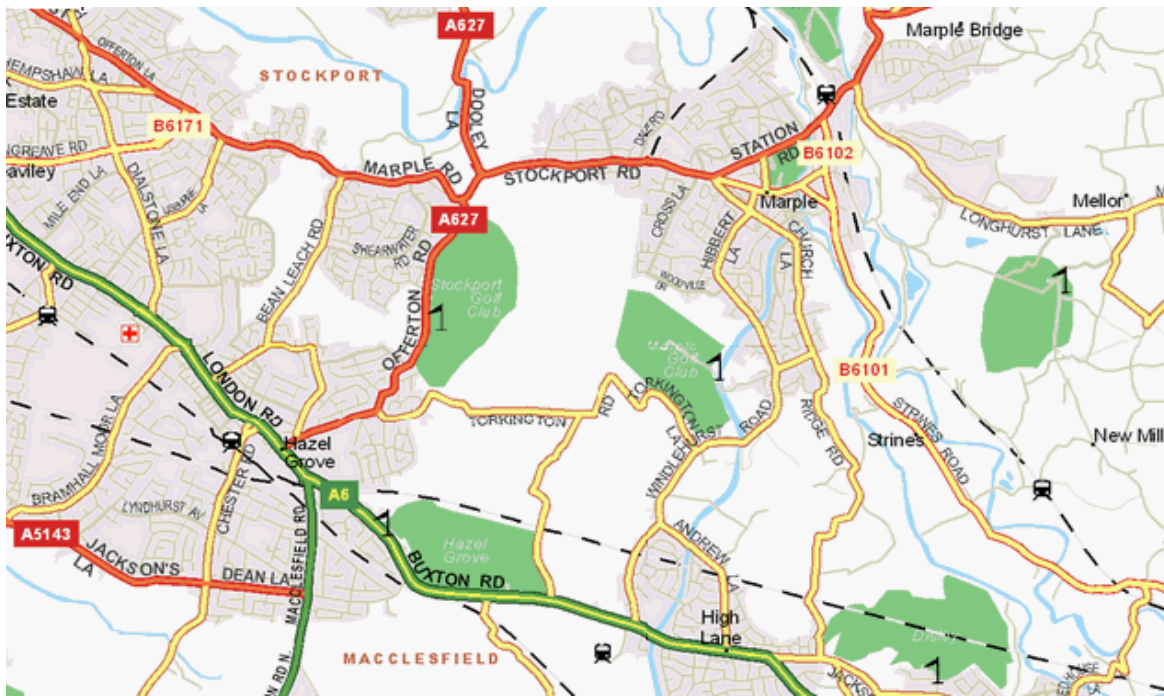

By road:

From M60 exit at junction 25 and at the roundabout follow signs to A560 Bredbury. Pass McDonalds on left then at next set of traffic lights turn left onto A560 (signposted Barnsley, Sheffield). At second set of traffic lights turn right onto Lower Bents Lane A6017 (signposted Hazel Grove). At Cow and Calf public house turn right onto Stockport Road A626 (signposted Marple). At traffic lights turn left onto Stockport Road A626 (signposted Marple). At Somerfield bear right onto Church Lane (signpost All Saints' Church). Continue over mini roundabout. All Saints' Church (and the vicarage) are about 0.5 miles from the roundabout on the left hand side of the road.

By Public Transport:

From Manchester, take the Marple train from Manchester Piccadilly (also calling at Reddish North, Brinnington, Bredbury and Romiley).

Turn right out of Marple station up the hill until you reach the junction with Hollins Lane. Turn left down Hollins Lane. At the traffic lights, continue walking along to the end of the pedestrian precinct. Turn left up Church Lane. Continue walking for half a mile up Church Lane until you reach the church, which is on your left.
