



Children and Youth Worker

Information about the post

The post of Children and Youth Worker at St Mary's Beverley has arisen out of a desire to see children and young people come to know Jesus and to grow in faith.

As Youth and Children's worker, you will take the lead in developing our youth and children's ministry. You will develop strategies for outreach and will create opportunities for relationships to grow and provide Bible teaching and prayer support to the young people you encounter. There are opportunities to run Messy Church, Youth Alpha, Diddy Disciples as well as to be creative and design your own courses, groups and activities. You will need to be able to speak confidently about faith in Jesus and to share the Good News of God's love. You will need to earn the respect of children, youngsters and their families. You will also need to exhibit high levels of professionalism including: excellent practice in relation to safeguarding, good time keeping, integrity and commitment.

You will be expected to liaise with schools, teachers and young people, as well as community groups such as the Guides, Brownies and Church Lads and Girls Brigade.

You will work closely with St Mary's ministry team and the vicar of St Mary's Church, and will be able to draw upon the support of an experienced team with a broad range of skills. You will organise events which draw young people and children to the church

The job is full time but could be part time for the right candidate. It is designed to provide flexibility for both the post holder and the Church. You will be based at the St Mary's Office in Beverley but there is scope for home working as negotiated.

The job will require regular outreach activities, both within Beverley and occasionally beyond. The Church team includes a small number of paid officers, and a wider community of volunteers.
