

Job Description: New Wine Discipleship Year Internships


All Saints Marlow and Lantern St Mary's Marlow Bottom

Do you want to spend a year working with a vibrant, multi-generational Anglican team? We are a group of ordinary people but we sense that our extraordinary God is leading us on a journey and we are inviting you to consider joining us on it as one of our Interns. The role of an Intern is a fantastic opportunity to explore your gifts and see God use you whilst serving and gaining experience in the context of a local church.

We are a friendly, welcoming church team with a wide range of ages and experiences. Some of us have worshipped here for decades. Others are right at the beginning of our spiritual journeys. We enjoy varied worship styles and try to generate a warm, friendly place in which to worship.

It is important to us that you feel at home and part of the church family therefore we would provide accommodation for you, offer a subsistence allowance (including paid expenses) as well as regular mentoring and support.

As part of the New Wine Discipleship Year programme (aimed at 18-24 year olds) you will benefit from teaching, mentoring and coaching and will spend one day a week (Tuesdays) at the New Wine training hub at St Paul's, Ealing.



We have a number of posts available at All Saints Marlow, and one post available at St Mary's Marlow Bottom. At All Saints, your time will be spent working alongside our staff team in a variety of different settings. These include children's work, the opportunity to build relationships with 500+ children at our church schools who are very proactive in sharing Jesus with the children in their care; traditional and informal worship teams, creative prayer, youth work and communications – dependent on where your heart and giftings lie.



Lantern St Mary's is an opportunity for you to be involved in a pioneering new ministry. You can get involved in all kinds of initiatives to reach out into the community of Marlow Bottom, particularly working with youth and children, and their families. Working with others, you'll get to impact primary school outreach through assemblies, lessons and lunch clubs; community service and action; and life in a church plant that only started in 2015! In addition, you'll have loads of other opportunities to work with worship teams, all ages of adults, prayer, communications and hospitality.

Wherever you are placed, we have opportunities for you to work inside and outside your comfort zones – but we will want to shape the role around YOU! Since the role includes working with children, you will be required to complete a DBS check before you can be appointed. You will also be required to follow our policies and practices for Child Protection, Health and Safety, and any other policies and practices that apply to your work.

Please also describe your Christian faith journey and detail any experience you have which you think is relevant. Please also state if you have a preference to be placed at All Saints Marlow or St Mary's Marlow Bottom.
